

2020 New Milford Parks and
Recreation Indoor Cornhole
Rules

2 players per team - must be same two players during a single game

Each game is to 21, first team to reach 21 wins

Closest to the hole, coin toss, or Rock, Paper, Scissors to be used to determine who chooses the initial side of board to throw from and whether to start out throwing first or second.

Throwing out of turn or outside the throwing box is a foul. The bag that was thrown when the foul occurred does not count and is immediately removed from play.

Partners stand on the opposite side from each other. This means that one player from Team A will throw from the right side of the board on one end and the partner will be throwing from the left side of the board on the other end.

Each side is permitted 4 warm up throws before starting each game, if desired.

Scoring is as follows:

- Bag on Board = 1 point
- Bag through Hole = 3 points
- Bags that hit the ground prior to landing on the board or going into the hole do not count
- Any bag hanging off the board and touching the ground does not count
- Any bag hanging in the hole only counts as 1 point
- Cancellation scoring is used at the end of each round. After all 8 bags have been thrown; the score is calculated based on the bags that remain on the board and have gone in the hole. If Team A has 4 points and Team B has 3 points, Team A will get 1 point
- A game is played to 21+. There is no win by 2 or bust rule for going over 21
- Representative from winning team will provide score in official notebook on the stage

Each win will be worth 3 points. Standings will be provided after play each week through email. Team with most points at end of regular season in each division will be named champion. After regular season, playoffs will be held to determine postseason champion. Winning teams will be provided with trophies.

Final rosters due fourth week of play.

Tie-breakers for playoff seeding is as follows if teams have same number of points:

- Win/Loss vs. Team
- Point differential during regular season
- Division record
- Team vs. Team Tie-breaker game
